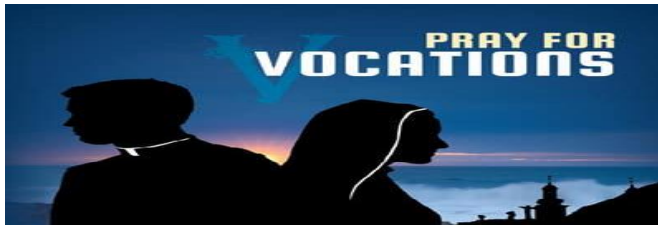

tuna, tomato sauce, canned fruit, canned vegetables, soups, baby formula, oil, jam, granola bars, juice boxes

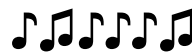
